DRIVING DIRECTIONS

DIRECTIONS FROM AUGUSTA:

From **northeast** on 15th St/GA-4 toward Harper St.

- Continue to follow 15th St.
- Merge onto GA-28 W via the ramp on the **left**.
- Merge onto I-20 W/GA-402 W toward **Atlanta**.
- Take the **GA-44** exit, EXIT 130, toward **Eatonton/Greensboro**.
- Keep **left** to take the ramp toward **Eatonton**.
- Turn **left** onto GA-44/Lake Oconee Pkwy. Continue to follow GA-44.
- Keep **right** at the fork to continue on GA-44.
- Turn **left** onto S Jefferson Ave/US-129 Bus S/US-441 Bus S/GA-44.
- Continue to follow GA-44.
- Turn **right** onto Gray Bypass.
- Turn **right** onto Gray Hwy/US-129 S/GA-18/GA-11/GA-22. Continue to follow US-129 S/GA-11.
- Merge onto I-16 W/GA-404 W toward **Atlanta**.
- Merge onto I-75 S/GA-401 S via the exit on the **left** toward **Valdosta**.
- Take the **GA-33 Conn** exit, EXIT 97, toward **Wenona/Sylvester**.
- Turn **right** onto Rockhouse Rd E/GA-33 Conn.
- Turn **left** onto GA Highway 33 S/GA-33. Continue to follow GA-33.
- Keep **left** at the fork to go on N Westberry St/GA-33.
- Turn **slight right** onto Ashburn Hwy/GA-112/GA-33. Continue to follow GA-112/GA-33.
- Turn **right** onto W Franklin St/US-82 W/GA-520.
- Take the 1st **left** onto GA-112/N Isabella St. Continue to follow GA-112.
- Turn **left** onto N Scott St/GA-112/GA-97. Continue to follow GA-112/GA-97.
- Turn **right** onto Bainbridge Rd/GA-97. Continue to follow GA-97.
- Turn **left** onto N Sims St.
- Turn **left** onto E Shotwell St/US-84 Bus E.
- 1500 E Shotwell St, Bainbridge, GA 39819-4256

1500 E SHOTWELL ST is on the **right**.

DEPARTURE INFORMATION

CHECK OUT INSTRUCTIONS

- Clean out ALL of your items from the refrigerator and pantry.
- Remove ALL trash from the apartment and place in outside garbage receptacle. **Trash pick-up is on Friday mornings.**
- A vacuum, broom, dustpan, mop, and other cleaning supplies are provided for you to use.
- Do not move furniture from room to room.
- If you are the last person to leave the apartment, please set the thermostat to a reasonable temperature and turn off all lights.
- Lock all windows and exterior doors.
- If an incoming student reports that the room is dirty upon his or her arrival, then you will be responsible for a \$50 cleaning fee and barred from AHEC housing for the rest of the academic year.
