Continue to follow GA-44.</li> <li>Keep right at the fork to continue on GA-44.</li> <li>Turn left onto S Jefferson Ave/US-129 Bus S/US-441 Bus S/GA-44.</li> <li>Continue to follow GA-44.</li> <li>Turn right onto Gray Bypass.</li> <li>Turn right onto Gray Hwy/US-129 S/GA-18/GA-11/GA-22.
