



- **Professionalism** timeliness, dress, communication
- Reporting history, exam, presentations, documentation
- Interpreting data interpretation, prioritization, diff dx
- Managing diagnostic/therapeutic plans; procedures; managing time
- Educating self-directed learning, response to feedback, interpreting literature, teaching others
