



What is Interprofessional Education?

"Intentional learning when students from two or more professions learn about, from, and with each other to enable effective collaboration & improve health outcomes"

The **AHEC Scholars Program** is a Georgia statewide initiative. The program is open to students enrolled in select healthcare certificate or degree programs. Students will receive 80 hours of innovative and interactive instruction (40 didactic and 40 hands-on IPE experience) in Year 1 and in Year 2. Core topics covered: Interprofessional Education (IPE), Behavioral Health, Social Determinants of Health (SDOH), Cultural Competency, Practice Transformation, Current and Emerging Health Issues. Requirements for the AHEC Scholars Program are in addition to regular coursework required by the student's academic program. Stipends will be provided to each student each year participating to assist with living expenses, travel, etc. Students will be selected through a formal online application process each Fall, and must culminate in graduation from a degree or certificate program.

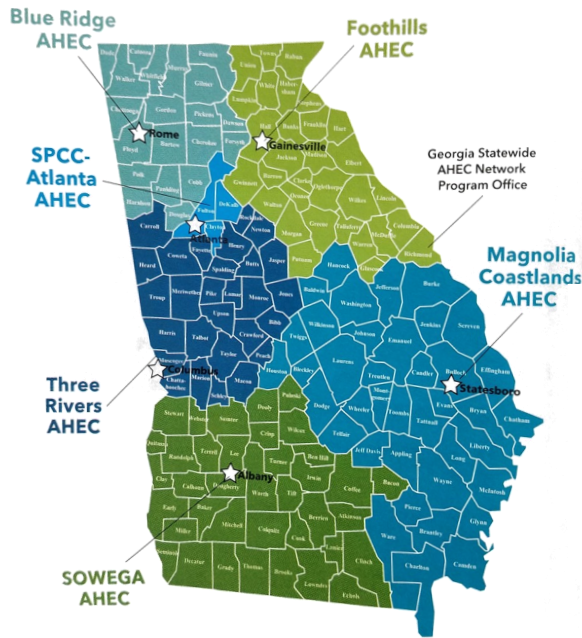
